**4. BMFA Briefing for 12<sup>th</sup> May full Council meeting**

- The Chairman explained the ongoing work to revise the Area Committee constitution.
- The Area's Council and the Tech Council are onside with the proposed structural changes to the management of the BMFA.

- Paul Hoey updated the meeting on the plans to celebrate 100 years of SMAE/BMFA in 2022. The Chairman reported on the successful event on 30<sup>th</sup> April at the Norwich Forum. Help was given by local clubs.
